Improving the Way the NHS Handles Complaints

In March 2015, the Public Administration Select Committee report characterised investigations into serious incidents in the NHS as "complicated, take far too long and preoccupied with blame or avoiding financial liability" and falling short of what people are entitled to expect. To help address this and ensure that for the most serious cases, patients, families and NHS staff get answers, and that the NHS learns from its mistakes, the Government is setting up IPSIS (Independent Patient Safety Investigation Service).
