Open Forum, 5 June, with London's Air Ambulance

A reminder that our next Open Forum will be on Tuesday 5 June, which is during PPG Awareness Week. Our guest speaker will be from London's Air Ambulance – whose helicopters are based at Northolt.

On average five people a day in London are so seriously injured that they need advanced life-saving medical treatment on scene, before they reach hospital. LAA advanced trauma doctors and paramedics can be by their side within minutes to perform medical procedures normally only found in hospital.

London's Air Ambulance is a charity and not a part of the NHS or the Emergency Services.

Everyone is welcome and we have extended an invitation to patients from other local Practices.

The Open Forum will be followed by the normal PPG meeting at 1500.
